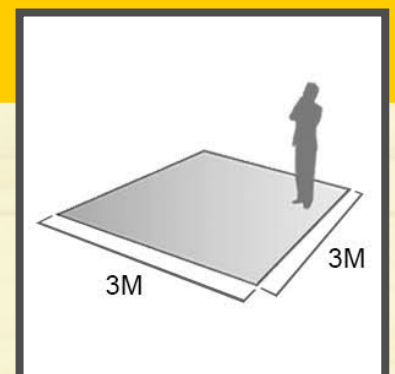

RULES AND REGULATIONS

A. Exhibitors and Registrants (hereinafter also referred to as Applicants) shall be bound by the conditions, rules and regulations set forth in this agreement and any changes must be made in writing and signed by an authorized official of Cooman Events Management Services. (hereinafter referred to as CEMS) who shall have full power to interpret and to make or amend these rules, provided that such amendments and additions do not operate to diminish the rights reserved for the Exhibitor/Registrant under this contract/application, and shall not operate to increase liabilities of its Sponsors, Agents or Employees.

G. Attendance hours shall be controlled solely by the exhibit committee, who will specify hours etc., and admission shall be by ticket or badge, and identification badges shall not be transferable.

H. J. The publisher of the catalogue, the exhibit committee, sponsors, its agents or employees will not be responsible for any errors or omissions on copy prepared and submitted by the advertiser or exhibitor.

K. The execution of the application and its receipt by CEMS is deemed conclusive evidence of the Applicant's agreement to pay the full fees due from that moment. The application is non-cancellable by the Applicant. Applicant further acknowledges that CEMS having incurred expenses as a result of the contract/application, is not required to refund any of the fees agreed to on the reverse side and that is also entitled to any unpaid amounts that may owe by the applicant to CEMS.

Furthermore, CEMS will not be responsible and will be held harmless from the consequences of any conflicts or misinterpretations arise with the host county, its sponsors, agents or other bodies regarding any and all aspects of the exhibition, which may affect the exhibitors. 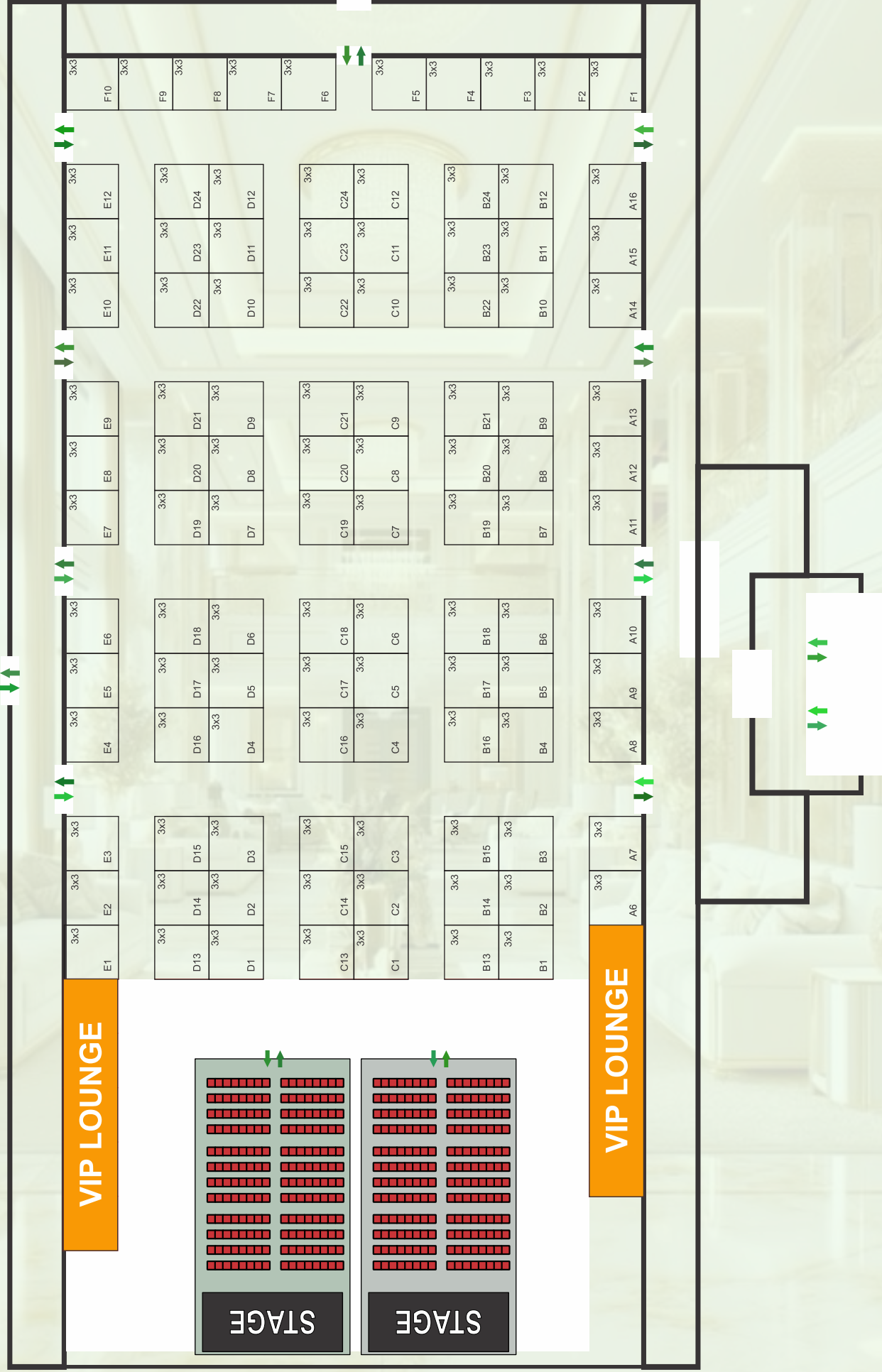
